



Mrs. Kirschner-Stabile currently serves as the Assistant Principal at Pittsgrove Township Middle School. In this position, her responsibilities include the attendance and discipline of Pittsgrove Township Middle School students, I&RS Coordinator, and School Testing Coordinator. She joined the Pittsgrove Township Administrative team in December, 2016 as the Assistant Principal of Administration and Instruction, fulfilling responsibilities at both the Central Office and the Pittsgrove Township Middle School.
