



Mr. Harris was appointed the District's Business Administrator/Board Secretary, January 1, 2017. His primary responsibilities include working cooperatively with the Superintendent and Administration to achieve district goals for pupils by providing leadership and supervision in the area of fiscal management. As Business Administrator, he also supervises the custodial, maintenance, food service, transportation and business operations staff.
