

SPECIAL EDUCATION PARENT ADVISORY GROUP (SEPAG)

Special Education Parent Advisory Groups are required for all school districts in New Jersey. The purpose of these groups is to provide opportunities for parents and community members to offer input to their districts on critical issues relating to students with disabilities.

New Jersey Administrative Code 6A:14-1.2(h) states that:

Each board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory group is in place in the district to provide input to the district on issues concerning students with disabilities.

The SEPAG will be meeting throughout the 2016-2017 school year. Our first meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 28, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. in the Child Study Team office. At this meeting, an introduction of some of the Child Study Team members and related service providers will take place. We will be discussing expectations for students with disabilities for the upcoming school year.
